2019 Charities

Bridge of Hope BuxMont

Since 1989, Bridge of Hope's program model has been implemented to end and prevent homelessness for single mothers and their children.

Garden of Health

Their mission is to provide special dietary foods (gluten free, diabetic friendly, etc.) and fresh produce to low-income families. They distribute this type of food to over 20 local food pantries. They also distribute fresh produce to low-income senior housing.

Saint Agnes Mission Project

Based in Upper Bucks and through fundraising efforts, this organization sends a group of teenagers to low income communities where they work together to feed, shelter, and support the local people by working at food shelters or to help build homes.

Pennridge FISH

Their mission is to provide for those in need in the Perkasie area by providing residents with clothing and food. They also offer emergency financial assistance to help residents in the Pennrideg community when a crisis arises.

A Woman's Place

This organization is a community-based social organizaton committed to the empowerment of women and to ending domestic violence. They offer a 24-hour a day hotline, free counseling services, and safer living options by providing a full service shelter.



Fundraising

Golf Outing

Money is raised through ad sales, golfer registrations, sponsors, and raffle tickets. Golfers enjoy a day of golf, food, beverages, prizes and knowing they supported a wonderful cause.

Cow Plop

A field is divided into 3' x 3' pieces of property, which are "sold" for a \$10 donation. In return, you get a "deed" for that property. A cow is sent out to the pasture. If the cow does its business on your property, you'll win a percentage of the total deed sales. There are first, second and third place winners. Total prizes awarded equal 20% of the deed sales.

Jeans Day

Employees of Merck Sharp & Dohme Federal Credit Union support the New Britain Charitable Foundation throughout the year by participating in Jean Fridays. For a weekly donation, employees are permitted to wear jeans on Fridays in lieu of their usual business attire.
